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PRODUCT DESCRIPTION:

Recommended for use in healthy dogs at 6 weeks of age or older as an aid in the control of disease associated with canine influenza virus infection. The type A, subtype H3N8 virus has been chemically inactivated and combined with an adjuvant designed to enhance the immune response. The vaccine has been demonstrated to reduce the incidence and severity of lung lesions, as well as the duration of coughing and viral shedding. This product is conditionally licensed.

DOSAGE/ADMINISTRATION:

Shake well. Inject one dose (1 mL) **subcutaneously**. The initial dose may be given at 6 weeks of age or older. A second dose is given 2 to 4 weeks later. A minimum of two doses is required for primary immunization. Annual revaccination with one dose is recommended. Use entire contents immediately.

PRECAUTIONS:

- Store at 2° - 7°C.
- Do not freeze.
- Do not mix with other vaccines.
- Vaccinate only healthy, non-parasitized dogs.
- Use new, non-chemically sterilized needles and syringes.

WARNINGS:

- Contains gentamicin and amphotericin B as preservatives.
- Do not vaccinate pregnant bitches.
- The use of a biological product may produce anaphylaxis and/or other inflammatory immune-mediated hypersensitivity reactions. **Antidote:** Epinephrine, corticosteroids, and antihistamines may all be indicated depending on the nature and severity of the reaction.
